NOTICE OF APPLICATION BY: CORIX – PANORAMA WATER Proposed Interim Rates Effective August 1, 2020

Notice is hereby given that Corix Panorama Water (Panorama) has made an application to the Comptroller of Water Rights for consent to the filing under the provisions of the Water Utility Act and the Utilities Commission Act of rates and charges for service. Effective August 1, 2020, Panorama has been granted an interim rate increase by the Comptroller of Water Rights. The interim rates are refundable with interest, subject to the final decision by the Comptroller of Water Rights.

The table below shows the proposed rates over three years from 2020 to 2022. The interim rate increase effective August 1, 2020 will be reflected on the bill sent to customers in September.
