NOTICE OF APPLICATION BY: CORIX – PANORAMA WATER Proposed Interim Rates Effective January 1, 2019

Notice is hereby given that Corix – Panorama Water has made an application to the Comptroller of Water Rights for consent to the filing under the provisions of the *Water Utility Act* and the *Utilities Commission Act* of rates and charges for service. Effective January 1, 2019, Corix – Panorama Water has been granted an interim rate increase by the Comptroller of Water Rights. The interim rates are refundable with interest subject to the final decision by the Comptroller of Water Rights.

The interim rates, shown in the table below are effective January 1, 2019 and will be reflected on the bill sent to customers in February.

The proposed rates reflect increases in operating and maintenance costs since 2010, which was the last time rates for Corix – Panorama Water were adjusted. Corix – Panorama Water proposes to discontinue annual contributions from customer revenue into the Replacement Reserve Trust Fund.
